Notice of Revised Determination on Reconsideration

By application dated March 16, 2022, a state workforce office requested administrative reconsideration of the negative determination regarding workers' eligibility to apply for trade adjustment assistance applicable to workers and former workers of Dometic Corporation, a subsidiary of Dometic Group AB, Elkhart, Indiana. The workers' firm is engaged in activities related to the production of absorption refrigerators, including liners and doors. The Department of Labor (Department) issued the negative determination on February 15, 2022. The Department's Notice of determination was published in the Federal Register on March 14, 2022.

The request for reconsideration states that production work has been shifted to Mexico.

During the reconsideration investigation, new information revealed that work was shifting from the subject location to Mexico.

Section 222(a)(1) has been met because a significant number or proportion of the workers in such workers' firm have become totally or partially separated, or are threatened to become totally or partially separated.


Section 222(a)(2)(B) has been met because the workers' firm has shifted to a foreign country the production of an article like or directly competitive with the article produced by the workers, which contributed importantly to worker group separations at Dometic Corporation, a subsidiary of Dometic Group AB, Elkhart, Indiana.

Conclusion

After careful review of information obtained during the reconsideration investigation, I determine that workers of Dometic Corporation, a subsidiary of Dometic Group AB, Elkhart, Indiana, who were engaged in activities related to the production of absorption refrigerators, including liners and doors, meet the worker group certification criteria under Section 222(a) of the Act, 19 U.S.C. § 2272(a). In accordance with Section 223 of the Act, 19 U.S.C. § 2273, I make the following certification:

"All workers of Dometic Corporation, a subsidiary of Dometic Group AB, Elkhart, Indiana, who became totally or partially separated from employment on or after June 14, 2020, through two years from the date of this certification, and all workers in the group threatened with total or partial separation from employment on date of certification through two years from the date of certification, are eligible to apply for adjustment assistance under Chapter 2 of Title II of the Trade Act of 1974, as amended."
