Additional Distribution of Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Funding  
for Training Level Services for WIA Eligible Dislocated Workers and Adults

**Purpose**

This policy announces the distribution of additional Workforce Investment Act Rapid Response and Discretionary funding to Indiana's Balance of State Workforce Investment Board's eleven Regional Workforce Boards and the Indianapolis Private Industry Council, the Marion County Workforce Investment Board. This policy replaces Indiana Department of Workforce Development's Technical Assistance Bulletin, TAB 2008-14.

**Rescission**

Technical Assistance Bulletin 2008-14, issued January 20, 2009

**Content**

Workforce Investment Act Rapid Response and Discretionary funding will be distributed to Indiana's Regional Workforce Boards and the Marion County Workforce Investment Board in accordance with the Dislocated Worker formula published in DWD Policy 2007-34, *Final Program Year 2008 Workforce Investment Act Adult, Youth, and Dislocated Worker Formula Allocations*, issued on April 21, 2008.

The intended usage for the allocation of this additional funding is to provide training level services to WIA dislocated workers and eligible adults throughout Indiana's regions and Marion County. The Department of Workforce Development anticipates that traditional Workforce Investment Act formula funding will provide core and intensive services for their participants and this new funding will provide training level services such as Individual Training Accounts only. In addition, administrative costs are not an allowable use of this funding. Using these funds for anything other than Individual Training Accounts and/or training vouchers must be pre-approved, in writing, by the DWD Director of Budget and Accounting.

These new Rapid Response and Discretionary funds being allocated by this policy must be expended by June 30, 2010.

**Process to Discontinue the Grant Process and Access the Additional Distributed Funding**

All Regional Workforce Boards and the Marion County Workforce Investment Board must discontinue any processes established in TAB 2008-14. All invoices that have been submitted to the Department of Workforce Development for payment under this TAB's instructions will be paid. Invoices that have not been submitted to the Department for payment should be held and paid with the funding being allocated in this policy. The Department will modify the November 2008 Rapid Response grants with each region and Marion County and add the additional WIA Discretionary and WIA Rapid Response funding listed below.
