Recently, BDDS announced that it selected six case management organizations* to provide waiver case management services beginning January 1, 2022. It appears that you or your loved one is not currently supported by one of the selected case management organizations. Therefore, it is important that you select a new case management organization no later than December 14, 2021.

Your current case manager has likely already shared information and resources to support you through the transition. If you are interested in continuing to work with your current case manager, you may ask them if they are continuing as a case manager and, if so, which selected company they will be working for. You may then contact that selected company and request to follow your current case manager.

In addition, BDDS is hosting multiple virtual, and in-person meet and greet opportunities for individuals and families to learn more about the CMOs. It is important to note that all of the awarded CMOs have CMs in your area who are knowledgeable of community resources. The upcoming in person meet and greet opportunities are as follows:
