





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TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR NEEDY FAMILIES (TANF)

Notes:

Reporting periods for SNAP Error Rates reflect the review period and Federal submission deadline. The month reported above is the month in which an action was taken included in the review sample.

Positive actions are those which produced an issuance of benefits to a household. Negative actions are those which closed or denied benefits to a household.

Error Rate data is reported by the state before the federal agency has accepted and finalized the results. This rate is subject to revision. Monthly numbers are taken from the end of the month totals. Error status of cases may be changed by either State or Federal Review process, which would cause a change that might not be reflected in the previous monthly numbers.







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SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (SNAP)







Beginning with May 2010 the SNAP IMPACT program became a voluntary program. This change resulted in a substantial reduction in the number of IMPACT cases.
